TAROT BASIC READING

The tarot reading was well-known in the 15 Century (the 20 Buddhist Era.) It first started with Gypsy crystal gazing. After the defiance of witches and wizards, the Gypsy changed from crystal-gazing to tarot card reading. At first, the meaning of the cards included the Christian idea and developed into the present day. The popular tarot card is Rider-Waite which is the model of many tarots nowadays.

Tarot reading is not difficult but to read accurately and profoundly, you must practice and train your mind to have strength. Practice meditation to be strong and have an understanding of your tarot cards. This book might not teach all methods but it compiles the fundamental knowledge for practicing reading tarot cards.

To read the tarot cards, you must starting understand the meaning of 78 cards, as each card has a different meaning.

Tarot cards can divide into Major Arcana which have 22 cards, or Minor Arcana, which have 56 cards. In Minor Arcana can divide into 4 types as follow:

- Coins (Earth Element) represent the externals.
- Cups (Water Element) represent emotions.
- Sword (Wind Element) represents logic.
- Wand (Fire Element) represents the internals.

Each card has its story and different meaning. We need to remember all of the signification first to read the cards. Nevertheless, to understand and interpret the definitions need experience. Sometimes, it does not need to be an upright meaning. It is up to the position, the side cards and the overview of all cards, so we do not need to remember all the implications but it is better to try to understand the meaning of each card deeply. Next, this book includes an explanation of tarot 78 cards. You can try to comprehend how to read the tarot cards.



THE FOOL

The upright meaning

This card means a person who loves freedom, no binding to anything. Follow his instinct and emotions. Enjoy his own life and do not worry. He has optimistic looking, lively and always stays happy.

The reverse meaning

This person lacks confidence, wavers and has no courage to face anything. So he always stays in the same place, that he becomes suppressed and lives his life in his safe zone, and put life at risk from lacking the courage to do something.



THE MAGICIAN

The upright meaning

This card means a philosopher who has wisdom, insights, and awareness of the world's prospects. He has a perception and can connect with what exists beyond this world, also receives support from the holy.

The reverse meaning

This narcissist thinks he's smarter than anyone. and be the center of the world. He can be narcissistic, exaggerate, deceive and look down on others. His personality can cause him trouble.



THE HIGH PRIESTESS

The upright meaning

This card means a gorgeous, mysterious and enlighten woman who could create glamour. Enchant others to do what she wants. She is hard to understand as she is a complex person who is peaceful but she is a hidden variance. And mysterious which is her charm.

The reverse meaning

This person lacks consciousness. Follow her inner feelings without hostility. She has no conscience and might have a high chance of doing immoral things.



THE EMPRESS

The upright meaning

This card means a woman with a kind heart who is loving, protecting and supporting those around her. The creator has a maternal instinct and is the initiator of life.

The reverse meaning

This person is a burden to others and unable to take care of anyone. She is old, looking unsightly and shabby. Those around hate her.



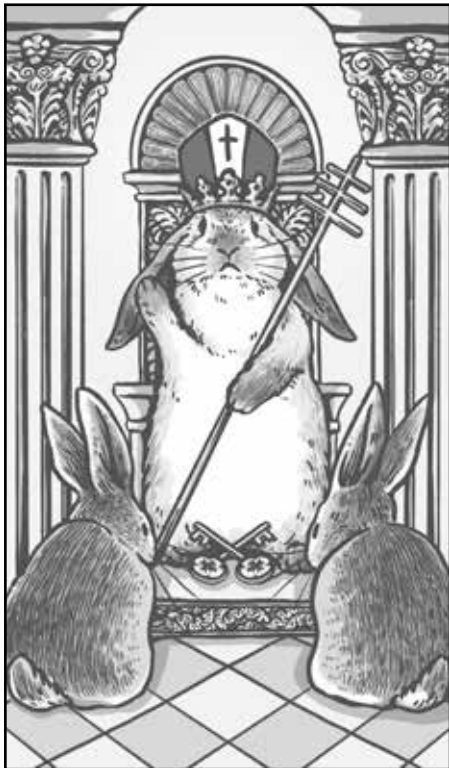
THE EMPEROR

The upright meaning

This card means a great emperor who is full of power and prestige. He is decisive and a strong leader. He is a trustworthy leader, truthful, arrogant and hard-headed.

The reverse meaning

This person has a dictatorship and loves to command. He is stubborn and doesn't listen to others. He is jealous and unreasonable that causes people to feel uncomfortable.



THE HIEROPHANT

The upright meaning

This card means a logical thinking person as a master, philosopher, guidance, and sage who always guide and advise the good things. With morals, the supernatural supported him.

The reverse meaning

This person is dishonest, unfaithful and violates morals. Includes breaking promises, customs and the law. That could cause trouble for those around him.



THE LOVERS

The upright meaning

These cards means love and want more than love. The need for worldly happiness. It also implicates passion, greed, unstoppable desire and choice of best thing.

The reverse meaning

This love is discord. They don't want to develop their relationship and will end it to find a better one.



THE CHARIOT

The upright meaning

This card means a chariot is ready to fight, competitive, and brave chariot. Sometimes this person is too reckless. They love to compete and discover new things. They are always open-minded and love to adventure.

The reverse meaning

This person is defeated. Even they try their best, they continue to lose. They are hopeless, have no chance to fight for victory. They have to give up and start something new.



STRENGTH

The upright meaning

This card represents strength, patience and dare to face without fear. Sometime it seems aggressive. There may be encounters to fight, should use courage, strong and patience to go through.

The reverse meaning

This person is discouraged and hopeless. Don't want to fight anymore. They admit defeat, insult themselves, and give up.



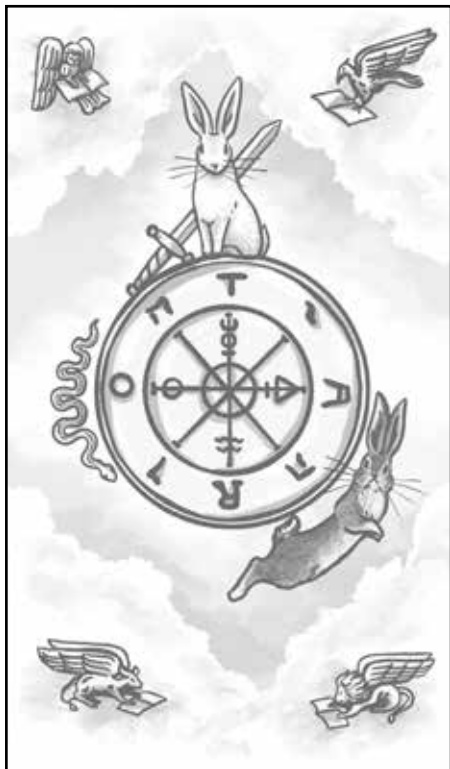
THE HERMIT

The upright meaning

This card represents an elder who isolates and secludes himself from the others. He is complacent with the modesty and full of talent. However, he chooses to avert from society and the world. He loves doing alone and not complicated.

The reverse meaning

This person gets tired of the present day. He wants to isolate himself and does not want to go back. It is completely forsaking.



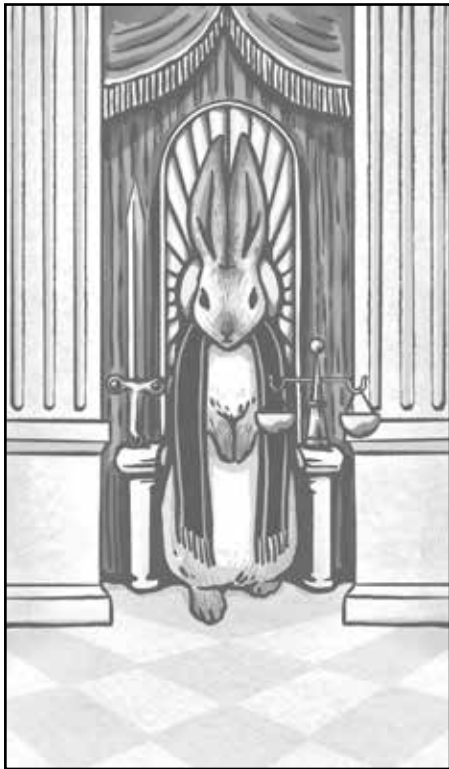
WHEEL of FORTUNE

The upright meaning

This card means the world spins according to the wheel of fortune. Life is changing. The result of an action will reveal soon. There is a good thing coming. This person has grace and luck.

The reverse meaning

Life changes to badly. They will encounter misfortune and gain karma.



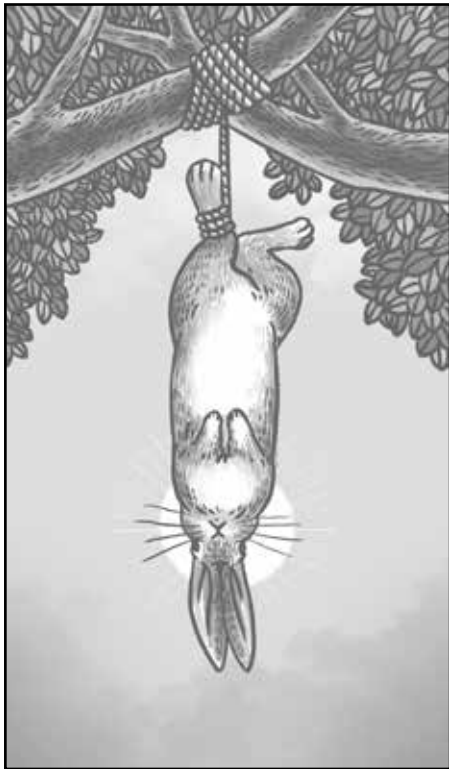
JUSTICE

The upright meaning

This card means a person who is justice, neutral, wise, wary and uses reason over emotion. He carefully makes decisions based on law and morality.

The reverse meaning

This person uses their violent emotions to decide things. They have a chance to use kangaroo court to break the law. Also, they are dishonest and would like to exploit people.



THE HANGED MAN

The upright meaning

This card refers to the person being hanged. Although, he seemed to be pained and confused but he balances between his mentality and patience. At the same time, he sees the truth in an unusual situation. He could see reality from a different perspective.

The reverse meaning

This person has to endure with the extremely uncomfortable situation. He doesn't have the consciousness and the wisdom to think about anything. He does not learn from the situations he had been through.



DEATH

The upright meaning

Death, which means the end, indicates an immediate transition from one state to another like an upside-down. It could be a good or wicked beginning. The meaning of this card is not as scary as it might seem.

The reverse meaning

This person cannot accept truth and change. They are hurt by changing or losing. They are stagnant to the same old things and do not open up to new things that are about to happen.



TEMPERANCE

The upright meaning

This card means a person who tests something to find the balance for their lives with a questions or a ways to find the answers that satisfies them.

The reverse meaning

The imbalance is happening both inside and outside, cause to conflicts and problems. They quarrel with the people around them because they don't adjust to each other.



THE DEVIL

The upright meaning

This card represents the demons in people's hearts that lure them into passion that is head over heels. Make them have no consciousness, doing immoral and depraved things. Also, use black magic.

The reverse meaning

This person feels guilty about what they have done but can't stop thinking about it. They get stuck with shame. They are in a dilemma that will be forever sinful. The voodoo reverses back to them.



THE TOWER

The upright meaning

This card means the destruction that happens unexpectedly. A cause of disasters, accidents that will cause a lot of pain. Must be wary of what will happen.

The reverse meaning

It means things are gradually decaying, which makes this person feel miserable and finally meets the eradication.



THE STAR

The upright meaning

This card means a star shines bright in the dark sky. It is the hope that completes the desire, cure mentality, and physical to continue to fight for survival.

The reverse meaning

This person is hopeless and desperate. They feel exhausted both physically and mentally as they want to give up and have no hope at all.



THE MOON

The upright meaning

This card means a person who is afraid and nervous about what they are hiding will get revealed as they sweep something under the carpet. If this person discloses and accepts the truth, they will feel relieved from this guilty feeling.

The reverse meaning

This person dares to face what they fear. They choose to fix the problem and move on with bravery. Accept and confront the truth.



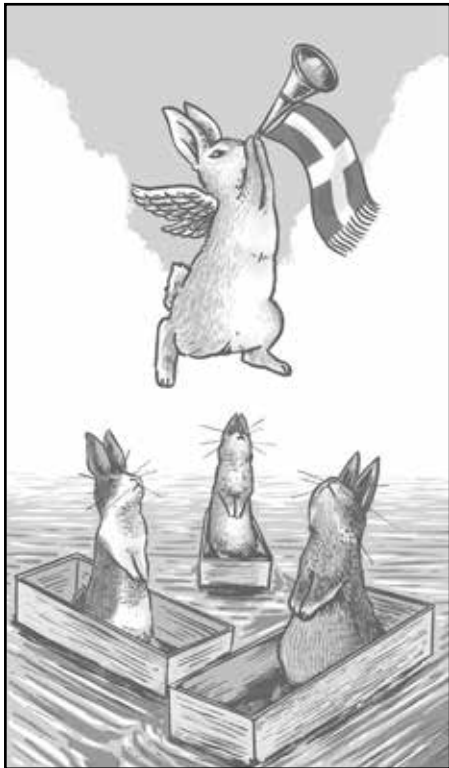
THE SUN

The upright meaning

This card means a person who shines bright and lively, full of joy and happiness in their lives. Good things happen while bad things will disappear. They will have happiness in everything.

The reverse meaning

This person has no passion for everything. They feel exhausted and want to take a break. Everything seems to be gloomy.



JUDGEMENT

The upright meaning

This card means making an announcement and informing everyone. There is no hiding because it demonstrates the outcome of what this person has done, as you reap what you sow. It is unavoidable because it is the equitable judgment of a higher power.

The reverse meaning

This person avoids the truth because they are unwilling to accept it and are embarrassed by themselves. They get judged by the outcomes. They want to change, but it is impossible since it is too late.



THE WORLD

The upright meaning

This card means a person who is satisfied with what they have. Everything is good and has no difficulty in life at all as all problems will get fixed. They are free from every bond. This world is theirs, and they see such a wonderful world.

The reverse meaning

This person's life does not go as well as they think it would be. The world is not supported and on their side. There is no freedom at all. They suppress their feelings and carry the whole world.



ACE of SWORDS

The upright meaning

This card means a person decides to fight. He has logical thinking and he is ready to confront any difficulties and obstacles bravely.

The reverse meaning

This person wants to start doing something, but he doesn't have a clear plan in his mind. He is in the process of trial and error, which makes him waste time, money and hurt his feelings. Also, the outcome is not effective either.



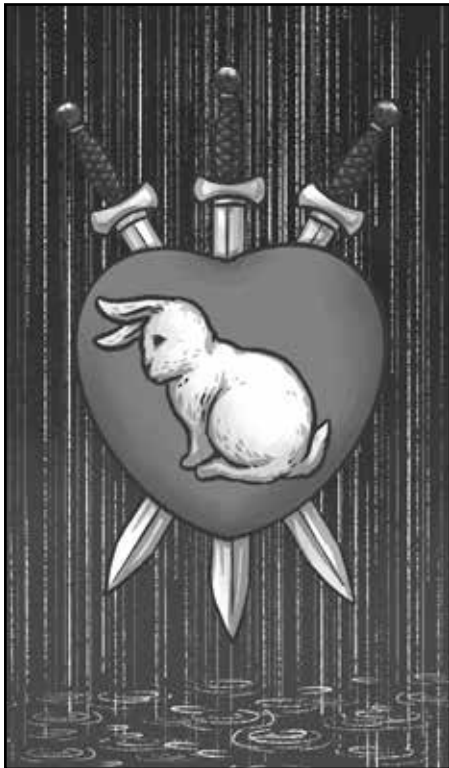
TWO of SWORDS

The upright meaning

This card means this person has a good choice to choose more than one. He is undecided which one he has to choose. Although he tries to use reason and logical thinking to make decisions but he still couldn't decide. It makes everything undone. His mind becomes a burden and confused.

The reverse meaning

This person is going to face the problems that come all at once. He needs to choose which issues he will fix and let the others go, even if it can cost so much damage.



THREE of SWORDS

The upright meaning

This card means the truth and reason that hurts a feeling. This person feels grieved after knowing the fact, the reality that distresses them.

The reverse meaning

This person must heal their heart and let go of logic and reason. Listen to their heart and mind.



FOUR of SWORDS

The upright meaning

This card means to rest, to hold, and to stay in peace for a while. What you are doing may not be finished but still choose to stop and let it go.

The reverse meaning

This person wants to take a break but they can't. However, they could not give up what they had to do and work responsibilities. They try to avoid it, but they have to do it reluctantly.



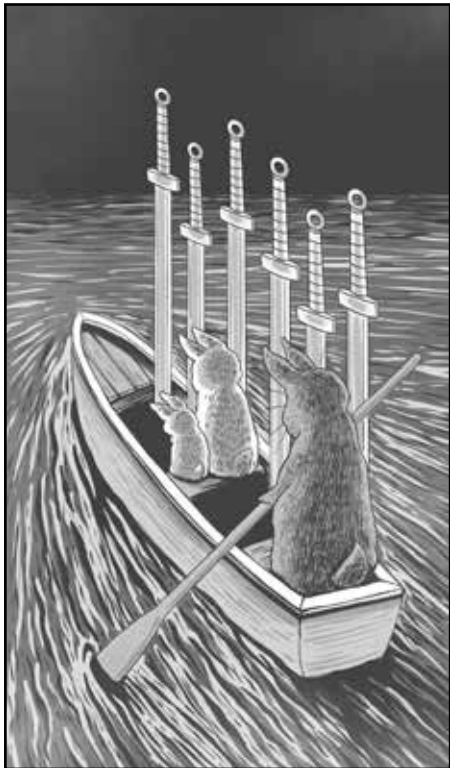
FIVE of SWORDS

The upright meaning

This card is meant to beat the opponents with thought, reason and logical thinking. There is a winner, a loser and losses. In the end, the result was a breakage, which has no benefits at all. Besides, it can mean this person is over-confident in themselves.

The reverse meaning

This person surrenders to letting things go, even if they do not feel happy about it as they are willing to maintain relationships with people.



SIX of SWORDS

The upright meaning

This card refers to the person who decides to depart and leaves everything behind. Even he leaves with a down feeling. It is reasonable to do so as he thinks of it thoroughly.

The reverse meaning

This person uses his reasoning to win and force the minds of others. In the end, everyone leaves him, or he gets a person's body, but not the heart.



SEVEN of SWORDS

The upright meaning

This card means stealing the idea or work and falsely claiming that this work comes from his concept. This person is selfish and deceptive. He always does something behind other people's backs.

The reverse meaning

This person's secret gets revealed, the truth comes out also what he hides too. It makes him feel ashamed. Get caught as a cheater, a thief.



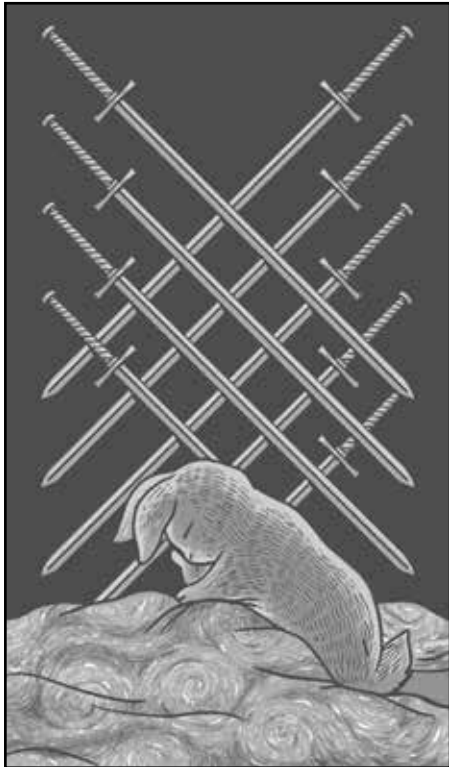
EIGHT of SWORDS

The upright meaning

This card means to surrender by the evidence, by the truth and by the reason. A person has no choice but to accept it. Although he does not like it, he has to admit it.

The reverse meaning

This person is walking away from the limitation. As things are getting better. Moreover, he can see the new perspective and has other options.



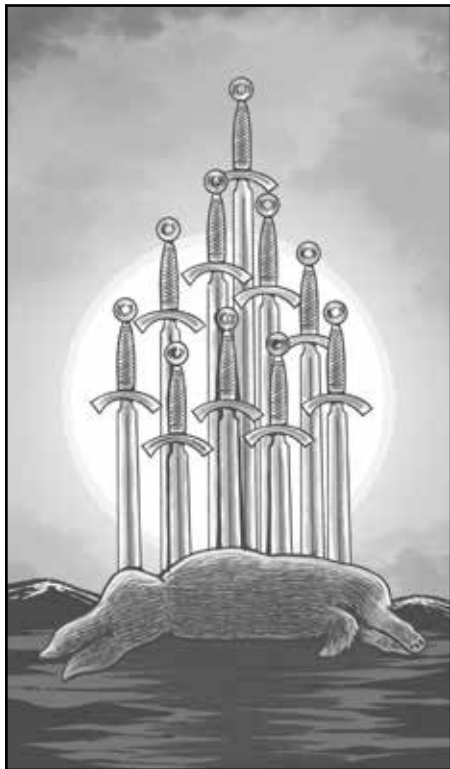
NINE of SWORDS

The upright meaning

This card represents a person who is overthinking and stressful. He has controversy in his mind and becomes depressed, anxious, insomnia, and has a nightmare. The mental condition is getting worse.

The reverse meaning

This person let go of tension. Even though the situation does not get better, he knows that over-thinking does not help. He gets to see a new way and begins to wake up from his bad dream.



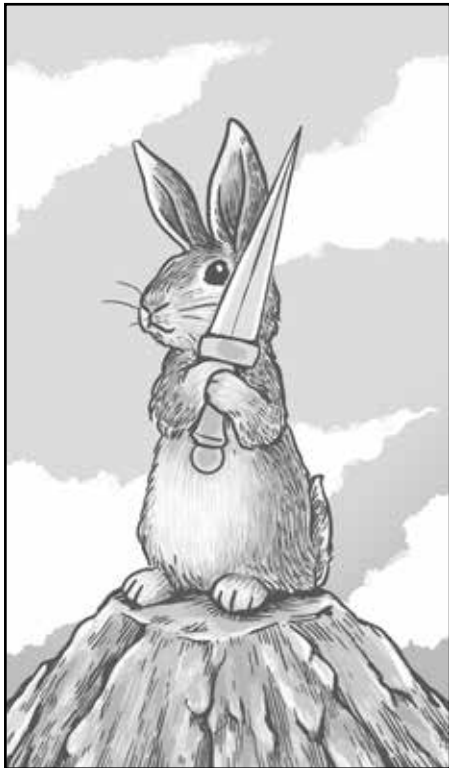
TEN of SWORDS

The upright meaning

This card means that the truth hurts a person like he died alive. He becomes a carcass that loses his feeling, his personality, and his confidence. He is a failure and a loser. Finally, he becomes a useless person.

The reverse meaning

This person still felt pain, and those around him aggravate and condemn him.



PAGE of SWORDS

The upright meaning

This card means ready to face what will come by using intelligence. This person is a child who lacks experience, it makes him impatient and stubborn but brave enough to confront the obstacles.

The reverse meaning

This person left the problem as it is and not interested in fixing any issues. He thinks it is none of his business and does not prepare for what will come.



KNIGHT of SWORDS

The upright meaning

This card means ready to face the obstacle with esprit. This person is willing to offer himself to fix the problem. He is smart and thinks fast. Sometimes, he thinks too fast that he lacks discretion.

The reverse meaning

This person solves the problem by using force. He is sloppy and has no responsibility. In the end, the obstacle becomes worse.



QUEEN of SWORDS

The upright meaning

This card means velvet glove. A person is always thoughtful and reasonable. However, her inner self is still susceptible women. Additionally, she has the knowledge, ability, and power in herself.

The reverse meaning

This person uses emotions over logic. She is calm, however, inside her heart is like a storm and ready to take everything down.



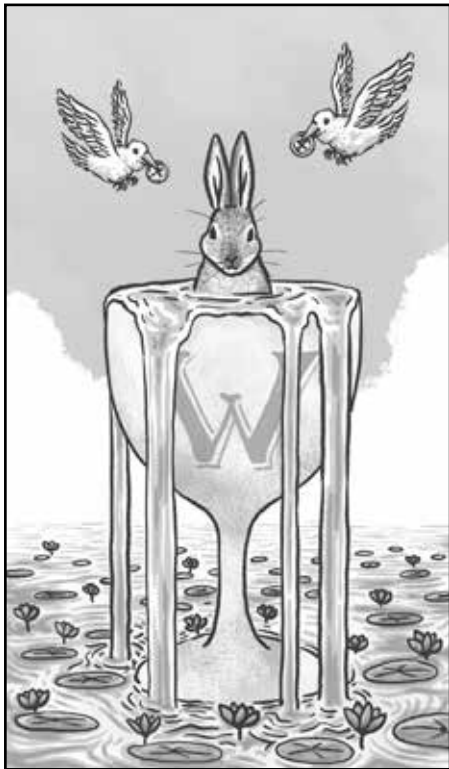
KING of SWORDS

The upright meaning

This card means growing up from the experiences, make his idea clear and sharp. And he does not use emotion. He is mentally strong and confident. He is a true leader because he always makes the right decision and takes all the responsibilities.

The reverse meaning

This person uses too much logic and wants to overpower that he becomes headstrong, swells with his pride, and becomes autocratic.



ACE of CUPS

The upright meaning

This card means to starting a new feeling or receiving a good thing and becoming happier. This person's life fulfills, it is a fresh start with pleasure and a sincere feeling.

The reverse meaning

This person is disappointed over and over again until they lose faith. They don't want a new beginning and don't think of doing it either.



TWO of CUPS

The upright meaning

This card means to meet someone with fatefulness, someone who can get along well in everything. No matter, this person can be a friend, lover, or partner. This card is the best amity card.

The reverse meaning

This person does not feel anything at all. There is no love and bond. They stop loving each other and break up.



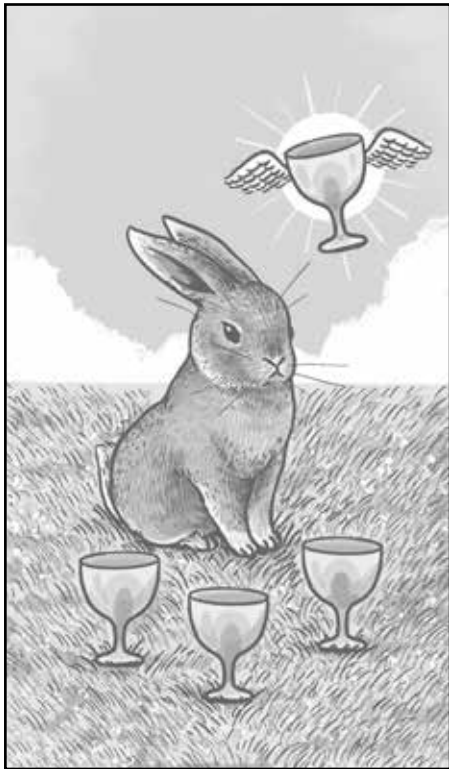
THREE of CUPS

The upright meaning

This card means a celebration, a meeting of friends, friendship, and happiness. This person has a good colleague, a family who are united and harmonious.

The reverse meaning

This person has a discordant opinion. They cannot work harmoniously, and splits up. Everything they do together comes to an end.



FOUR of CUPS

The upright meaning

This card means choosing what is the best for themselves. This person hesitates whether what is in front of them is the best thing, they don't even select this path. Although that can lead them to disappointment or worthy ways.

The reverse meaning

This person is too picky and eventually let the good chance away. It's too late, those things passed but later regret. So it is better to be satisfied with what they have.



FIVE of CUPS

The upright meaning

This card represents regret and sorrow over things that have already happened. They are stagnant in sorrow. If they can't change the past, just let go and start over in the present.

The reverse meaning

This person gives themselves a chance and begins again, move forward. There are no guilty or mortified feelings anymore.



SIX of CUPS

The upright meaning

This card means warmth and generosity. A person shares a good feeling, makes us feel like a kid who is taken care of by the adult, or they are an adult who gives kindness to the child.

The reverse meaning

The sadness and grievances will come back. An atrocious memories are being excavated and the forgotten bad things are about to appear that make us gloom again.



SEVEN of CUPS

The upright meaning

This card means having a lot of imagination and creativity. This person has a lot of things they want and also has a lot of goals. They seem to have so many things to do that it becomes muddled.

The reverse meaning

This person has so many projects but is not realistic. They are too dreamy that he forgot themselves. They are someone who sleeps in sweet dreams but do not wake up to do anything at all.



EIGHT of CUPS

The upright meaning

This card means to accept the problem and move on without regret. Let everything behind forcefully. It seems like the person gives up and walks away, but it also means conquering yourself and moving on.

The reverse meaning

This person is not brave enough to walk away from the situation they face. They don't let go and not moving forward, they stay at the same spot and are stuck with the same feelings they have.



NINE of CUPS

The upright meaning

This card means an abundance of love, career, and money. However, this person is exaggerating and narcissistic, which can cause relationship problems with others.

The reverse meaning

This person is a glass full of water and doesn't want to know anything else. They are very narcissistic that people around them feel uncomfortable. They don't listen to any opinion, which makes those around them disperse.



TEN of CUPS

The upright meaning

This card means the overwhelming of happiness. It means a family is full of joy which makes those around these people feel jubilant too. If they have an obstacle, the delight has not decreased at all. They always think positively, make the world bright.

The reverse meaning

This person is unhappy, loose everything. Their lives are gloomy and make those around them feel distressed too. Finally, the people around them will be gone.



PAGE of CUPS

The upright meaning

This card means a lively child who always years to learn new things all the time. They are enthusiastic and optimistic, which can be a careless person. They also have six-sense and believe in their instinct.

The reverse meaning

This person is childish and choleric like the youngest child who is too self-indulgent, which can cause a mess to their job.



KNIGHT of CUPS

The upright meaning

This card represents a person who uses his heart to determine his actions and life. He is confident, sensitive, romantic, understands the feelings of others and care for others. That is why many people love, and foster him.

The reverse meaning

This person uses too much feeling that it becomes immoral. He is a glib and liar. Moreover, he is not sincere and takes advantage of people.



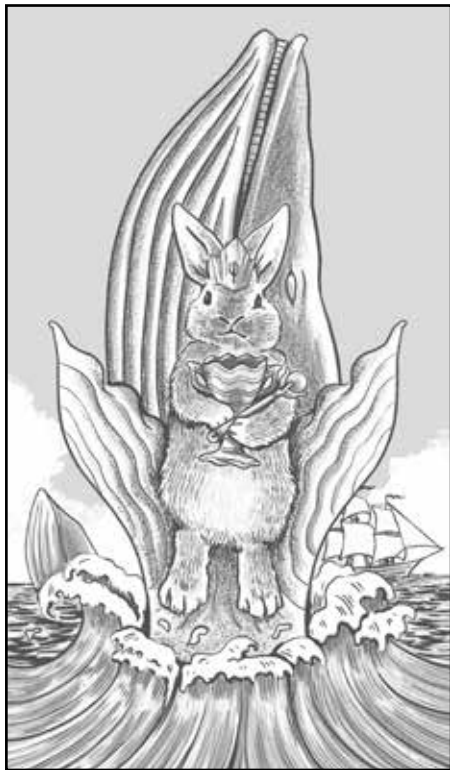
QUEEN of CUPS

The upright meaning

This card means to have a strong six-sense. She is sentimental, change quickly and curious person, but consciously control her emotions. Moreover, She is able to understand and accept the fact with kindness and warmth.

The reverse meaning

The six-sense that cause the fear to be exorbitant. She threatens others. Also, she is always furious, which causes trouble for those around her.



KING of CUPS

The upright meaning

This card means consciousness and emotional stability. A person can overcome obstacles with his ability. He is loved and depended on by others in the same way that a large tree provides shade and warmth.

The reverse meaning

This person is mindless, temperamental and impatient. Despite having good knowledge, he is unable to control himself. Making it difficult for him to succeed.



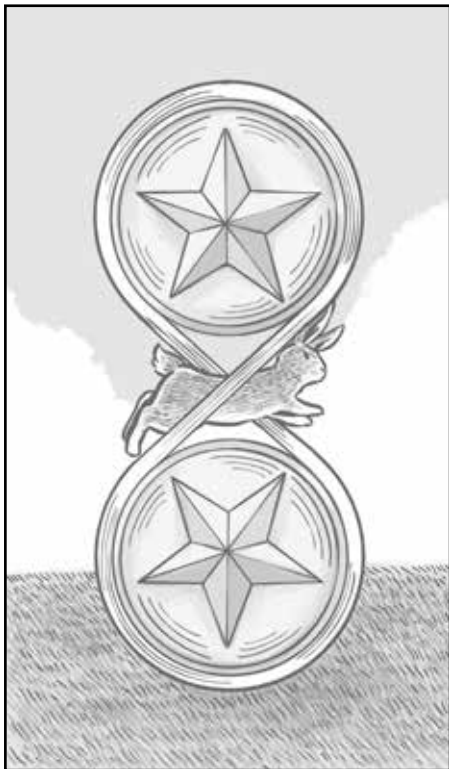
ACE of PENTACLES

The upright meaning

The reverse meaning

This person loses money. The money they invest does not yield a good return, paid and not worth it. They started with mistakes. Whether they want to start over or not, is entirely up to his decision.



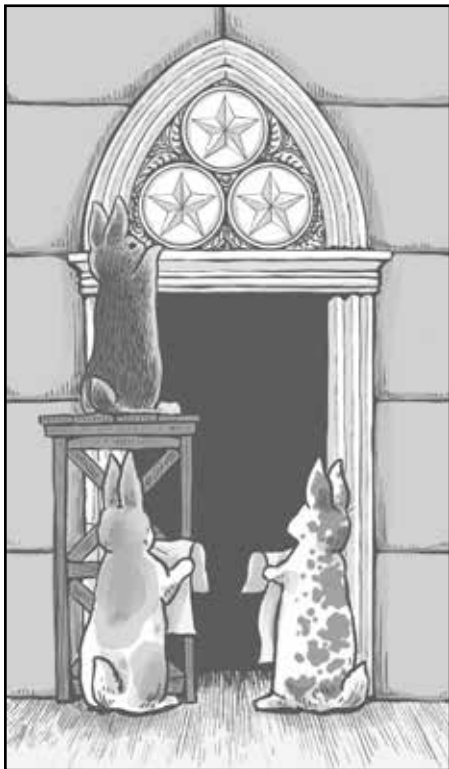
TWO of PENTACLES

The upright meaning

This card means a person balances and adjusts themselves. This person is agile and slimy. Furthermore, they have management abilities and are adept at problem-solving.

The reverse meaning

This person makes mistakes and loses of what they have done. No matter if it is career, financial, or love. They can't deal with many lovers, not making money in time, not working in time cause losses and damage.



THREE of PENTACLES

The upright meaning

This card means a person who plans to collaborate with friends or colleagues with different skills. They plan and work together as a team.

The reverse meaning

This person doesn't trust and believe the skill of the team. They are disunited, wasting money and time, and losing.



FOUR of PENTACLES

The upright meaning

This person is a thrifty person who knows the value of what he has and doesn't want to waste. This person sometimes appears to be an introvert and a stingy.

The reverse meaning

This person loses what they have kept for a long time. They also lose all the money they kept as they have no choice.



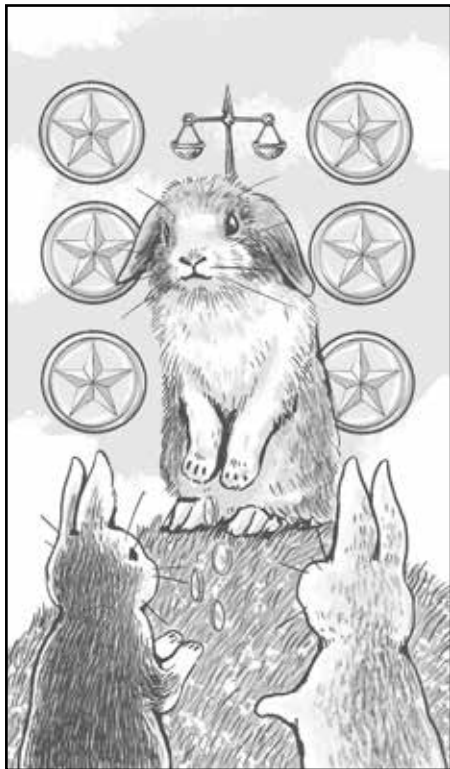
FIVE of PENTACLES

The upright meaning

This card means a person is pauperize without honor and support. They can't make a living, being driven to become homeless.

The reverse meaning

The lowest point finally comes to an end. Everything becomes still. Nothing worse, but nothing gets better either.



SIX of PENTACLES

The upright meaning

This card represents giving and receiving, as well as sharing equally. However, this person must be wary of internal bias, which could lead to prejudice.

The reverse meaning

This person wants to be a receiver. They feel slight as they give so many things but do not get anything in return. They start to speak up with the person they had given away as they think it is unfair.



SEVEN of PENTACLES

The upright meaning

This card means waiting to collect the investment. This person invests and works very hard. They put in a lot of effort filled with hope, and that time is approaching.

The reverse meaning

This person misses the best opportunity, so they don't get enough good profits as they do not make hay while the sun shines.



EIGHT of PENTACLES

The upright meaning

This card represents a person who has patience, determination, diligence, saving money little by little. They work hard and have high concentration, and also they are meticulous in their work.

The reverse meaning

This person makes a mistake to work, so they are upset. They have to stop doing what they do and start over from the beginning.



NINE of PENTACLES

The upright meaning

This card means happiness, wealth, and everything is perfect. The harvest is endless as each flourish.

The reverse meaning

This person is afraid of losing things they have. They are frightened of change and changing status because everything now is good.



TEN of PENTACLES

The upright meaning

This card means a person's late-life with many offspring. Their lives are brimming with love and wealth. They can retire from work and have someone take care of them warmly and comfortably. It is an ideal late life.

The reverse meaning

This person has no one to take care of. The health, career and financial deterioration.



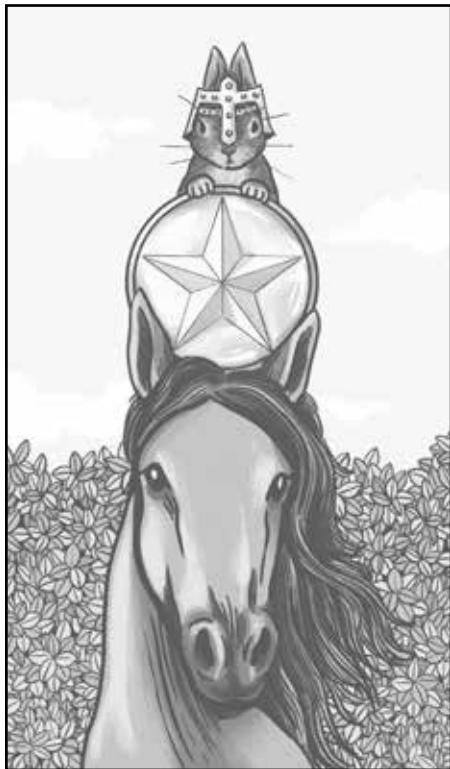
PAGE of PENTACLES

The upright meaning

This card means that a little child dreamer is given the opportunity to do what he thinking. He needs to prove his skills to follow his dreams. He must try his best not to lose it.

The reverse meaning

This person let the opportunity slip away. He loses what he loves because of his innocence. He thinks the chance he receives is a small matter, so he does not pay attention. He has to wait for the next time and does not even know if it will come again.



KNIGHT of PENTACLES

The upright meaning

This card means a person sees business opportunity. He has a business knowledge, smartness, and foresight. He has the courage to take risks in his investments.

The reverse meaning

This person sees no way out, despair and opportunity. He burns out to working.



QUEEN of PENTACLES

The upright meaning

This card means a sugar-mommy who takes care and supports in love. She is also good at handling assets. If she is not pleased, she will not give anything or let a scammer fools her.

The reverse meaning

This person is materialistic. She is overly concerned with money, which causes her to be frugal, distrustful of others and bossy.



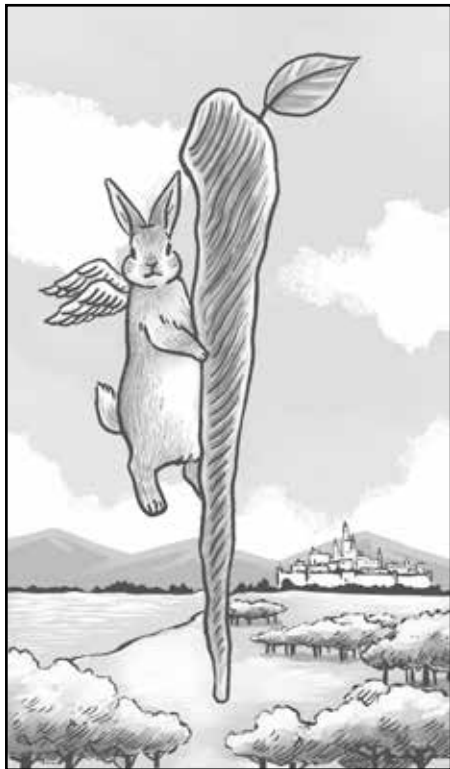
KING of PENTACLES

The upright meaning

This card means a magnate who earns money in everything he does. This person's business is good. He is wealthy, powerful, and has good fortune.

The reverse meaning

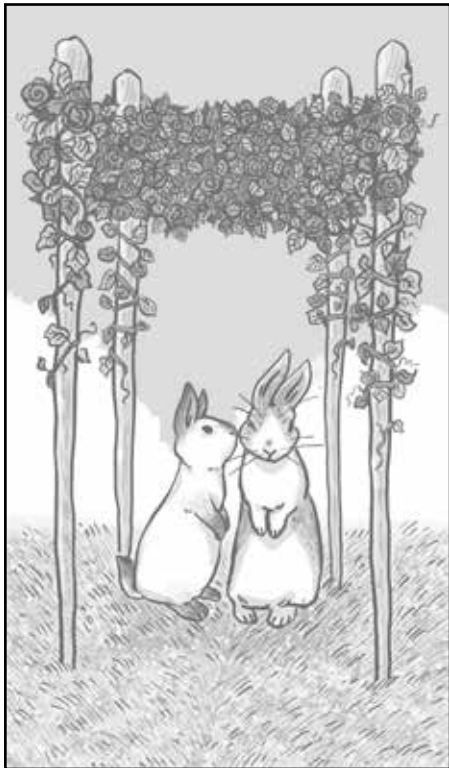
THREE of WANDS

This person lets things happen and go because he does not value a prospect he receives. Moreover, he likes to stay at home and is not interested in outside matters.



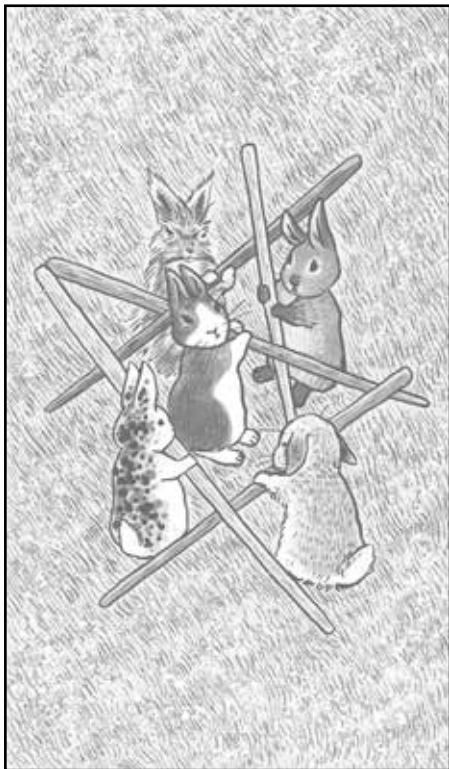
FOUR of WANDS

The conflict this person faces comes to an end. They may get tired or change the team to avoid problems. Things start to get better, and they discover the way to fix issues.



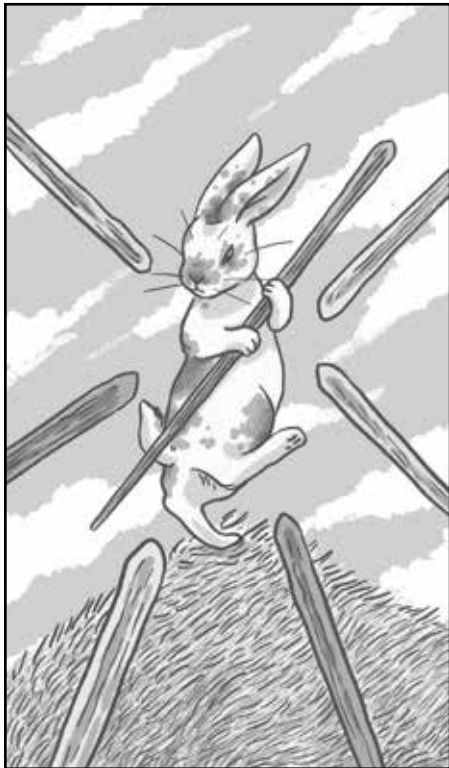
SIX of WANDS

This person stays at the wrong place and wrong time. No matter how hard you try, it will not prosper. There is no reward for what they have always done. Makes them feel neglected and discouraged.



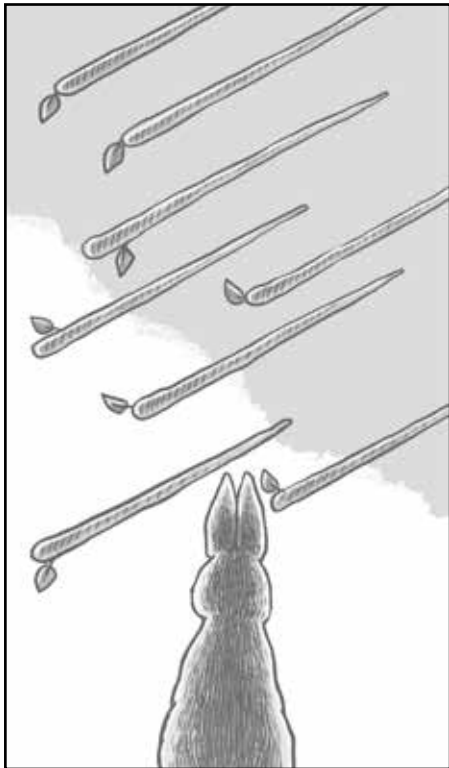
SEVEN of WANDS

Everything passes quickly, but this person cannot keep anything. They lost the great opportunity which they later regretted.



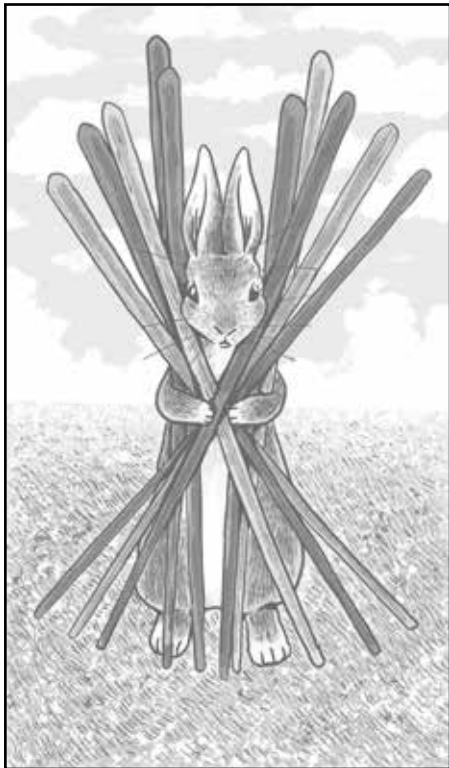
NINE of WANDS

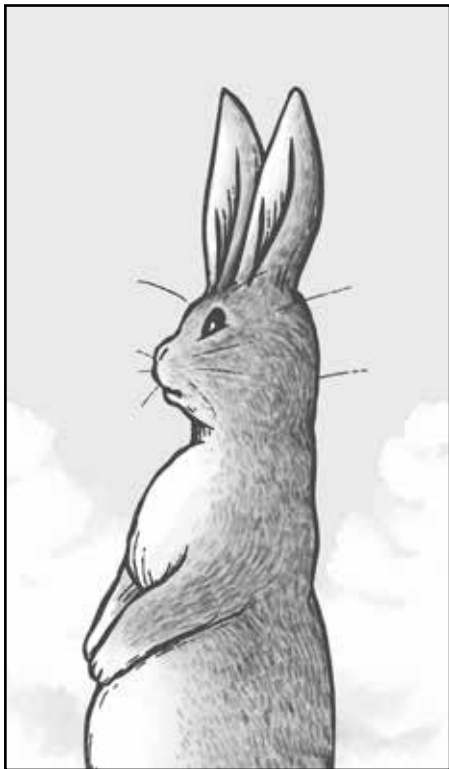
BINKYDAY

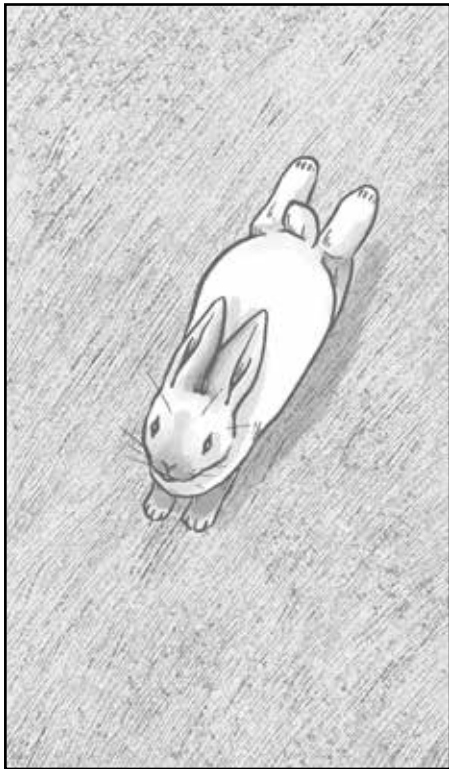
AWARENESS

You are always in need of plenty of flowers to put up a facade of having a wonderful life that is extravagant and deceitful because it was truthless.



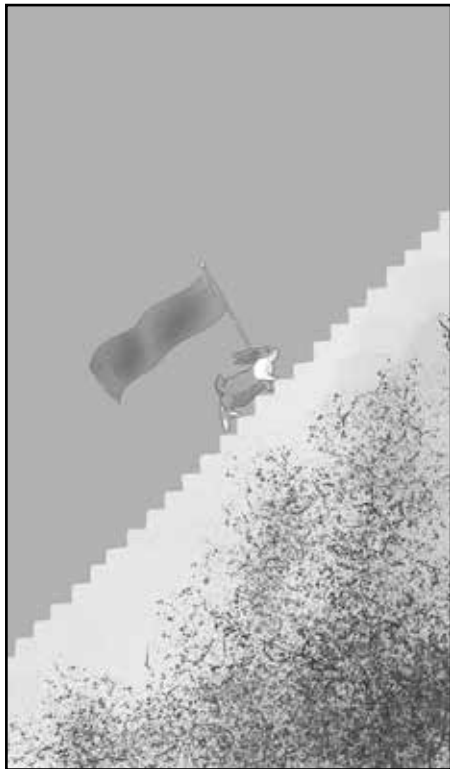
BLUE SKY

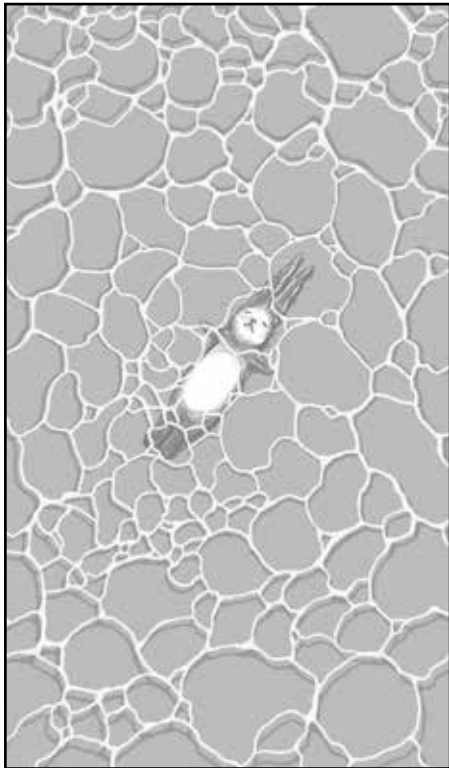
DEEP INSIDE

Exhausted and worn out. Wish to relax and get someplace. To be drained to go on is like running a long distance and being exhausted, even if you just take a half-step out.



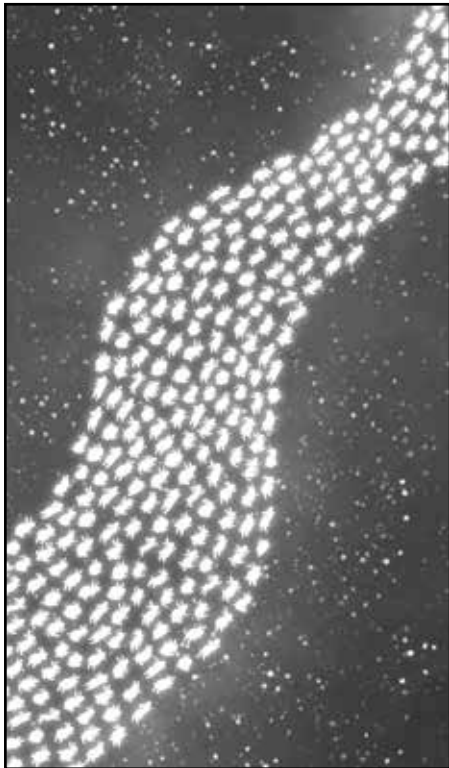
MOONLIGHT

ONE CARD TAROT READING



Reading one tarot card is the easiest way.
You can follow these steps below.

1. Ask your tarot card one question, and it should be simple. For example, Should I eat this? Should I buy this? Like it or Is he angry?

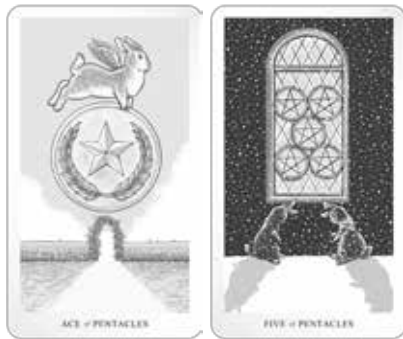

4. Open the card, which is the answer to your question.

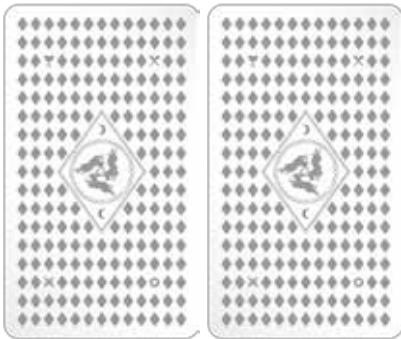


Reading one tarot card is forthright. For instance, if you ask a question, will this person love you? And you get The Lover card. It means they definitely love you.

TWO CARDS TAROT READING

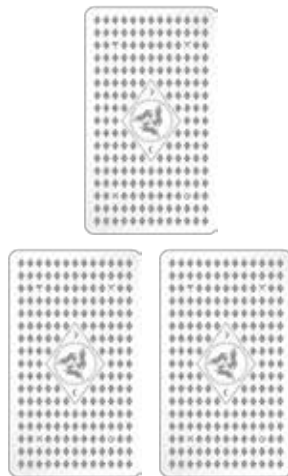
When you question, *“How does he feel about you?”* Then receiving *“The Hanged Man,”* card would undoubtedly show that *“he’s confusing,”* especially when paired with the second card of *“Two of Swords,”* which signifies that *“there’s more than one great choice.”* All of those cards may be interpreted as *“he’s confused because he has more than one great choice.”*

If the second card turns, for example, to “*Page of Cups*,” which means “*Begin studying about the relationship*,” this could be defined as “*he’s confused because the relation’s just beginning, he’s unsure and doesn’t know what to do. So you should just take very good care of your relationship with him.*”



As one can see, if the second card changes, the entire meaning changes as well.

THREE CARDS TAROT READING



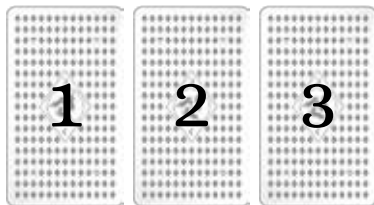
Three-card readings are much more complex than one-card and two-card readings which involve the position of the card’s significance.

The three-card reading approach is picking three cards, reading the cards in order of appearance, and lastly reading the meaning of the cards depending on their position.

The procedure is as follows:

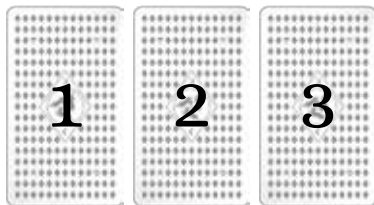
1. Draw the cards into question on purpose.
2. Shuffle the deck and pick three cards.
3. Lay out the cards face down.
4. Carefully open the first card and read the message in order until all three cards have been explained.
5. View a summary of all cards.

Three cards readings are assigned the function of the card's position, which allows the meaning of the card to be defined more diversely and complexly, where the position of the card is often described in a multitude of ways, such as



- The first position symbolizes identity.
- The second position symbolizes what would be coming in.
- The third position symbolizes overview.

Each position can change the function based on their preferences, such like:



- The first position symbolizes the past.
- The second position symbolizes the present.
- The third position symbolizes the future.

The three-card reading may be read as a storyline in which the meaning of the card changes depending on its position; for example, if the “Ace of Wands” is in the first position, it might be read as “you have a great desire to begin a new project.” However, if it was the last position, it may be changed to “it’s preferable to stop what you’re doing and focus on the new things that are coming.” Reading three cards needs imagination, comprehension, and a multifaceted combination, all of which need experience. Despite this, reading the tarot cards is similar to reading a short story that can be read and summarized in a short amount of time, such like:

- The first position symbolizes identity.
- The second position symbolizes what would be coming in.
- The third position symbolizes overview.

The position of the cards appears in the following position, and the cards are picked in the order listed.



You will be able to read the cards as follows:

1. For your identity, pick a “Seven of Cups” card, which symbolizes “There is plenty to desire for.”

2. For things that are coming to you is the “*Four of Cups*” card, which symbolizes. *“Something is going on and it was a nice offer, but you were uninterested.”*

3. For your summary is “*The Sun*” card, which symbolizes *“bright, brilliant, and joyous.”*

These three cards might simply mean *“You have a lot of wish lists and offers to pour in, but you’re so demanding. However, you have no regrets because you are already pleased.”*



Yet, if the final card is dealt, the “*Five of Cups*” symbolizes the title “*The Sun*,” which means “*Regret of passing.*” So, the whole meaning is changed into:

“You have a lot of wish lists and offers to pour in, but you’re so demanding. And then, in the end, you will lose all of them, regretting your previous actions. It’s too pity you didn’t take advantage of the opportunity.”

As you can see, when the one card changes, it affects the overall meaning of the card readings, which has a significant impact more than the two-card readings as three-card readings are more complicated and profound.
